Four Baltimore cyber security firms are finalists for a 2014 Maryland Incubator Company of the Year Award.

Integrata Security, Light Point Security, iWebGate and ASET Partners will compete in the homeland and cyber security category of the competition. All four firms reside at bwtech@umbc.

In total, 22 companies have been named finalists among seven categories in the awards competition. In addition to cyber, the categories include life sciences, green and information technology.

ZeroFOX, formerly Riskive, won top prize in last year's cyber category. The Federal Hill firm competed against ADASHI Systems and Light Point Security. ZeroFOX has since moved out of the Betamore incubator and announced plans to open sales offices in San Francisco. The firm recently closed an \$11 million Series A funding round.
