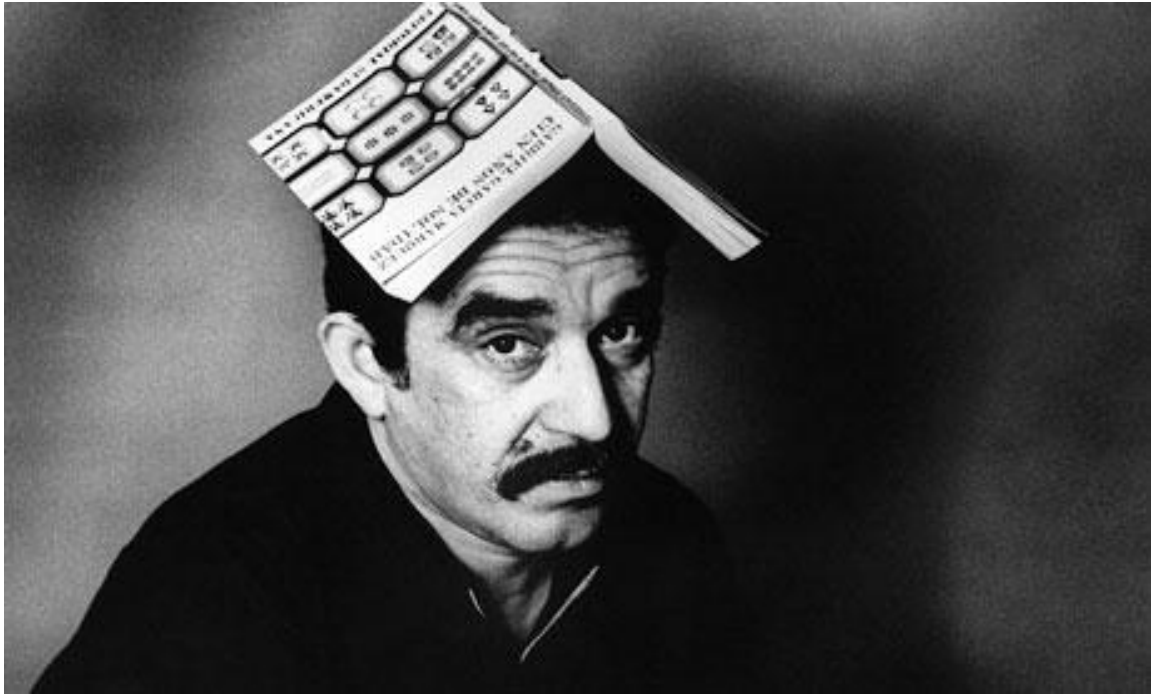


Reading and Remembering GABRIEL GARCÍA MÁRQUEZ
