While extremely expensive protection does exist, there is also a market for cheap, yet extremely effective protection. Make sure to find the protection which you find most effective and comfortable. While we don't know what type of ear protection will best work for you, below is a list of cheap safety equipment that other club members recommend and their estimated prices:

Eye Protection:

Eye Protection for people who don't wear prescription glasses:

- Remington T – 72 Shooting Glasses
 - Lens Colors: Amber, Blue, Clear Anti-Fog, Clear, Copper, Smoke
 - \$4 - \$7

Eye Protection for wearers of prescription glasses:

- 3M Peltor Eyeglass Protector Shooting Eyewear
 - Lens Colors: Clear
 - \$5 - \$10

Ear Protection:

Disposable Ear Plugs:

Reusable Ear Plugs:
