The Choice Program provides a community-based, family-centered case management approach to youth development and delinquency prevention. A signature program of UMBC and The Shriver Center, it is a nationally recognized initiative that serves Maryland's youth.

INTENSIVE ADVOCACY

The Intensive Advocacy Program provides a cost-efficient and effective alternative to the incarceration of youth. Youth and families involved in the juvenile justice system receive intensive monitoring, youth development and linkage to resources.

IOBS

The Choice Jobs Program prepares youth from Baltimore's most challenged neighborhoods for the work world. The program utilized a supported employment model that delivers community-based vocational services that include a job readiness curriculum, paid on-the-job training experience and supported job placement.

EDUCATION

The Choice Education Program provides an intensive case management alternative to inschool arrests, suspensions and expulsions. Choice Education Fellows provide school based advocacy, after school programming and cultural enrichment activities.


