Ridership Rules

- Standees are permitted except on vehicles without handrails or on the highway.
- No smoking, eating, using alcohol, drinking, or littering on the bus. Passengers can have their riding privileges revoked for these activities.
- All passengers must be stationed behind the driver. No one is permitted to sit on the right of the driver, blocking the door or aisle.
- UMBC is not responsible for lost or damaged articles. Items found on the bus will be held in the Transit office at the Warehouse.
- Inappropriate behavior on the buses is prohibited.
 Inappropriate behavior is defined as anything which distracts the driver. The driver has authority to eject from the bus, or refer to the University Police, any passenger who persists in such behavior.
- Except in the case of an emergency, use of emergency exits and equipment is prohibited.
- The driver is the final authority on the vehicle.
