All officers shall be elected to a term of one year starting and ending on May 1st Those with terms starting on December 1st will hold elections between November 15th - November 30th, and those will terms starting on May 1st will hold elections between April 15th - April 30th. In addition, in the case that a vacancy occurs in the positions of the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary elections will be held to fill these positions.

At least 1 week venture of notice shall be given before the annual election meeting. Choose 1 - 4 weeks

Voting method:

Nominations shall be initiated from the floor and elections done by a ballot where:

recording and archiving information from meetings and activities
